All these sentences about the story are false; please correct them. (Try not to look at the writing again!)

Example: This is a story from China. ~~India~~

1. Gopal and Nataki live in a big house ~~near~~ ^{small} a river.

3. Every day Gopal goes shopping ~~to the river~~ ^{fishing}
4. Gopal catches fish with a spear. ~~net~~

16. When Gopal tells the fish what Nataki wants, the fish says: "Hello!". ~~Goodbye~~
17. When Gopal goes home, Nataki is ~~queen~~ ^{has nothing.} of the country.
18. Gopal ~~sees the fish in his net one or two more times.~~ ^{never sees the fish again.}
